

School Parking.

Please be aware of the following offences under the City of Rockingham, Parking Local Laws 2004.

4.1(3)(b) Parking contrary to signs or limitations. A person shall not park a vehicle in a parking area, except in accordance with both the signs associated with the parking area and the provisions of this local law. 4.2(1)(a) Parking against the flow of traffic. A person shall park a vehicle on a two-way carriageway, as near as practicable to the left boundary of the carriageway and headed in the direction of the movement of traffic on the side of the thoroughfare on which the vehicle is parked. 4.5(2)(f) Parking on footpath or pedestrian crossing. A person shall not park a vehicle so that any portion of the vehicle is on any footpath or pedestrian crossing. Parking within 10 metres of an intersection. 4.5(2)(k) A person shall not park a vehicle so that any portion of the vehicle is within 10 metres of the nearer property line of any thoroughfare intersecting the thoroughfare on the side on which the vehicle is parked. 6.2(2) Stopping in a bus zone. A person shall not stop in a bus zone, unless the driver is driving a public bus, or a bus of a type that permitted to stop at the bus zone by information on or with the 'bus zone' sign applying to the bus zone. 7.9 Stopping on verge. A person shall not stop a vehicle so that any portion of it is on a verge, unless you are the owner or occupier of the adjacent premises, or have authorisation from the occupier to stop on the verge. 7.15 Stopping in disabled parking area. A driver shall not stop in a parking area for people with disabilities unless the driver's vehicle displays an ACROD sticker.

Rangers are patrolling schools on a daily basis to assist in implementing the School Road Safety and Parking Awareness Program. Please ensure you abide by the parking signs and local laws surrounding your school.

Parking Infringements will be issued to offending vehicles. Maximum Penalty \$5000.
